- These attract millions of visitors each year, and for a reason. They're just great.
- Forget for a moment the bustle and stress of modern life and travel back to a simpler age
- Breathe in the aroma of sausages, the sweet smell of toffee apples and the fragrance of countless scented candles.
- Fill your eyes with the soft lights and dazzling displays of artists, cooks and shopkeepers.
- Then eat, drink and generally be as merry as a reindeer in a carrot field.

EVENTS AND ACTIVITIES

Many museums, palaces and other attractions stay open throughout the Christmas period, but there are some seasonal sights and sounds to enjoy, too.

Traditional extras around the Rathaus Christmas market are choir singing and brass bands.

In 2017, the bands play around the Christmas tree from 8pm to 8.30pm each day from December 1 to December 23.

The choirs sing in the Festsaal (main chamber) of the Rathaus (city hall) itself and come from all over the world. Performances take place on Fridays, weekends and public holiday afternoons from December 1 to December 24. The entrance is the front center of the Rathaus. You can also find a choir singing most days at around 6pm on a stage within the Christmas market itself.

SNAKE TITANOBOA

Did you know that the snake Titanoboa is the biggest snake ever found in the world?

The snakes described above are big. Some are really big, but they are no match to the Titanoboa. This is by far the biggest, longest, and heaviest snake ever found and it weighed more than a 1000 kg and measured approximately 50 feet in length. In 2009, the fossils of the Titanoboa (*Titanoboa cerrejonensis*) were found in Colombia's coal mines of Cerrejón in La Guajira, where around 58 million years ago, these giant

snakes slithered in swampy jungles and forests of South America. These giant snakes could swallow whole crocodiles.

Their name Titanoboa means literally "titanic boa". They are extinct and lived during the Paleocene epoch, a period of 10 million years between 56 a 66 million years ago. For all these honorable mentions, these might not be the biggest in the world but they are the biggest of their type or in their region.
